Every interpretation of constitutional law starts with a certain constitutional theory, which is usually not made explicit by the interpreter or revealed by the interpretation itself; many times the interpreters do not even give an account of their theoretical position. The lecture will analyse the interrelation between fundamental theoretical positions and the interpretation of constitutional law.

Uwe Volkmann is professor of public law and legal philosophy at the Goethe-University Frankfurt am Main. His lecture is based on his book "Grundzüge einer Verfassungslehre der Bundesrepublik Deutschland" (Fundamentals of Constitutional Theory of the Federal Republic of Germany) and his article "Rechts-Produktion oder: Wie die Theorie der Verfassung ihren Inhalt bestimmt" (Law Production or How Constitutional Theory Determines its Content), which was published in the law journal "Der Staat" in 2015.
